sense of community. In a few weeks, we are excited to bring our Vivace String Orchestra to the Valle

Our three levels of string orchestras - Toccata, Sinfonietta and Vivace rehearse weekly as do our chamber ensembles. These groups are complemented by our Early Strings Training Program, now in its third year. ESTP is designed as a launchpad for families of beginners offering access to instruments, private lessons, and monthly group instruction. We are proud that this program is inclusive of all families, regardless of economic background, and provides personalized, one-on-one lessons with our talented faculty. Watching these young musicians graduate from ESTP and progress into our string orchestras has been a deeply rewarding experience.

Our impact is also expanding in the North County. We were recently honored to receive a renewal of a generous grant from the City of Buellton, which will allow us to offer a 16-week introductory strings course free of charge to youth ages 5 to 14. The program was incredibly impactful last spring and we are grateful for its continuance this coming year.
