Attendance and Communication

Attendance and good conduct at every rehearsal is important to each student's musical development. Students are responsible not only for their own experience, but for the experience and learning of their fellow students. The following applies to orchestra, chamber groups or any Strings program:

Attendance at rehearsal, concerts or other performances is mandatory.

Be on time for rehearsal. Arrive at least 15 minutes early to unpack and tune.

Be prepared: bring music binder with current sheet music and pencil.

Up to 2 absences will be excused per semester due to schedule conflicts or illness. Please list known schedule conflicts thru May 2025 (and Email as other dates come up):

Unexcused absences for 3 rehearsals results in the student being moved to the back of that orchestra section. For chamber groups, the student may lose the ability to participate in the ensemble (without refund).

An accumulation of 4 late arrivals is the equivalent of 1 absence.

If a rehearsal is/will be missed, send an email immediately to sbstrings@gmail.com , and report reason, such as illness. Clear communication prevents misunderstandings.

Conduct

We expect that every student understands the value and distinction of participating with other students equally committed to quality musicianship. Continuing to foster that positive, respectful, engaging and supportive environment, students will adhere to the following guidelines:

Display maturity at all times, use common courtesy, and stay engaged.

Do not engage in use of inappropriate language or disruptive behavior.

Do not bully, harass or intimidate others. Any form of physical or emotional abuse, or unwanted contact directed to another will not be tolerated.

Foster mutual respect and trust with fellow students.

Family Communication and Student Support

Santa Barbara Strings, the student and family members work together to support the musical education of each student. You understand that a commitment to attendance and engagement is so important to the student's success and to the success of the program.

Continue private lessons for the student, and support proper care of the student's instrument.

Mark your calendar with rehearsals (regular and dress) and concert dates.

Review your calendar and the program calendar early. Please notify us of scheduled conflicts as soon as possible, and email as soon as they arise.

Support your student's health. We are committed to your student's health and wellness. Absences due to illness will be excused.
